RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR PARTICIPANTS AND SPECTATORS

Please read carefully-Premise's owner/leasee does not guarantee your safety.

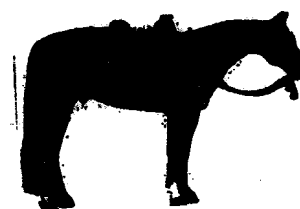
- *Classes may be split if size dictates.
- *Horses that show management deem as unruly or posing a danger to the rider or any other exhibitors will be excused.
- *Age of exhibitor is determined as of January 1st, 2010.
- *Proper attire required, formal attire not required.
- *Youth exhibitors may not show stallions in any classes.
- *ASTM helmets are required for all 17 & Under classes when mounted-no exceptions.
- *Ruling of the judge is final.



- *Please park trailers and cars to allow as many people to park in the area as possible.
- *Warm-up times and breaks will be scheduled and announced prior to the show if warm-up arena conditions are poor.
- *The show management or judge reserves the right to refuse entry to anyone.
- *Children should be under the supervision of an adult. Please ask permission before approaching unfamiliar horses.
- *Please pick up trash and manure and put them into cans located on the show grounds.
- *Owners are responsible for their horses at all times.

HIGH POINT RULES:

- Each show has a High-Point and Reserve rosette for 17 & Under and 18 & Over (horse/rider team). There is no fee for this-just sign up in the office.
- The High Point Horse and Rider team for the entire series (17 & Under and 18 & Over) will be awarded a Custom Montana Silversmiths buckle. There is a one-time fee (\$10.00) to count points for this award.
- High-point form and fee must be in the office PRIOR to your first class to have points count. No retroactive points will be pointed.
- High point awards will be counted on a horse and rider team. If you would like to have more than one horse shown, please fill out a form for each horse. Points will not be combined.

Equine Activity Release and Hold Harmless Agreement

1. I, _____, the undersigned have read and understand, and freely and voluntarily enter into this Release and Hold Harmless Agreement with Kill Creek Arena (Company), understanding that this Release and Hold Harmless Agreement is a waiver of any and all liability(ies).

2. I understand the potential dangers that I could incur in mounting, riding, walking, boarding, feeding said horse; including, but not limited to, any interactions with other horses. Understanding those risks I hereby release that Company, its officers, directors, shareholders, employees and anyone else directly or indirectly connected with that Company from any liability whatsoever in the event of injury or damage of any nature (or perhaps even death) to me or anyone else caused by or incidental to my electing to mount and ride a horse owned or operated by Kill Creek Arena.

3. I understand and recognize and warrant that this Release and Hold Harmless Agreement, is being voluntarily and intentionally signed and agreed to, and that in signing this Release and Hold Harmless Agreement I know and understand that this Release and Hold Harmless Agreement may further limit the liability of equine professionals to include any activity, whatsoever, involving an equine, including death, personal injury and/or damage to property.

I recognize and agree that I know which equine professional(s) I will be working with, and acknowledge that I agree said equine professional(s) has/have made reasonable and prudent efforts to determine my ability to engage in the equine activity, and has/have sufficient knowledge of my equine and horseback riding skills as to relieve, release and hold harmless said equine professional(s) from any continuing duty to monitor my equine activities.

I further voluntarily agree and warrant to Release and Hold Harmless this (these) equine professional(s) from any liability whatsoever, including, but not limited to, any incident caused by or related to said equine professional's (s') negligence, relating to injuries known, unknown, or otherwise not herein disclosed; including, but not limited to, injuries, death or property damage from: mounting; riding; dismounting; walking; grooming; feeding; use of horse barn, paddock, trails or horse ring, in any capacity; falling off horse whether horse is bucking, flipping, spooked; or my failure to understand any equine professional's directions relating to my riding or otherwise use and control, or lack thereof, of my horse or the horse I have been assigned to.
